

# Living in the Star

YOU'RE probably wondering what haute couture shoes and a high-rise building have to do with each other.

Well, apart from the fact that they're both skyscrapers, it's also because shoe couturier Datuk Jimmy Choo has been appointed ambassador for the prestigious Star Development.

The new property comprises Star Residences, which are luxurious residential homes (three towers of residential condominiums), and Star Boulevard, a six-storey signature retail, F&B and entertainment hub.

The site will also feature Malaysia's first and only Star Walk of Fame – a 200m-long stretch featuring both local and international celebrities.

The new property is developed by Alpine Return Sdn Bhd, backed by property developers Symphony Life Berhad (previously known as Bolton Berhad) and United Malayan Land Berhad (UM Land).

precisely the qualities that embody Star Residences,” said Alan Koh, chief operating officer of Alpine Return.

Choo marked the occasion by being the first international celebrity to be inducted into the Star Walk of Fame with an imprint of his hands.

The new Star Walk is set to be Malaysia's newest tourist destination in a few years' time.

He also offered some memorabilia from his outstanding career to be featured at the expected Michelin star restaurant in the Star Boulevard.
